Evening Activity Options:

We can offer Instructor led evening activities at a cost of £15 per head for 2 hrs activity. Activities include:

Orienteering- Scavenger hunts- Camp fire activities and bush craft- Wildlife walks- Team Games- Mountain boarding- Swimming- Archery- Canoeing

Some schools choose to run their own evening activities such as team games and walks. Access to water and rocks areas are restricted when instructors are not present, however you will have access to outdoor spaces for games, a small classroom for table tennis and board games and a large marquee.

All activities are subject to change in the event of bad weather (high winds / torrential rain) or risk assessment issues. Alternatives will be provided including, coastal walks, navigation exercises, creative workshops, team games, sports activities.

Catering

We can offer a domestic kitchen with exclusive use for your group. Facilities include a large preparation area. Range style cooker, microwave, jacket potato oven, fridge freezer and all cooking utensils and crockery. The eating area is rustic but effective – wooden benches outside or in our marquee.

We have a camp fire and barbeque area that can be used for evening meals. Most schools bring all dry foods (cereal, pasta, potatoes, bread etc) with them and we can arrange for a supermarket shop of additional items to be ordered for your arrival if required. The local supermarket is 5 miles away so top – up food can be bought if necessary!

Residential Facilities

We have a camping area suitable for up to approx 35 children and staff. This includes a basic bunk house building with 14 beds split 6 / 8 with an adjoining door, and tents which sleep up to 8 children. Showers and toilets are close by. Staff usually choose to stay in smaller tents or in the bunk house. An off-site overnight "on call services" is included. An on-site "on call service" can be booked at £60 per night.

Residential packages include:

- Activities as booked(early finish on last day)
- On site (Summer) or Off site (Winter) accommodation
- Mini bus transport for up to 32 people for localities 1, 2, 3 and 4a (subject to availability)
- Access to our marquee, student room, BBQ area and kitchen facilities during the evening
- Certificates of achievement

Staff accompanying the group will not be charged, but we encourage you to get involved with the activities and support the instructors with pastoral care, changing for activities etc.
