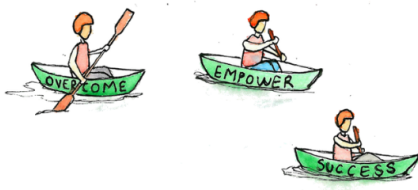

Job Description

Job Title: NCS Assistant Team Lead
Salary/Hourly Rate: £3,096 fixed payment plus holiday pay
Term: Temporary Fixed Term Contract (29th June -21st August 2020)
plus Graduation Event (23rd & 24th September 2020)
Hours: Variable, to be confirmed
Responsible to: NCS Co-ordinator

KEY TASKS

- To support a group of 15 young people throughout the programme
- To actively get involved in all daily activities whilst guiding your team
- To provide support and direction to all group members throughout
- To help the group through to completion of this Personal and Social Development programme
- To monitor students' physical and mental welfare throughout the course
- To liaise and communicate with Team Leader effectively
- To be aware of all policies & procedures, including Health & Safety and Safeguarding
- To complete all registers and reports in a timely manner
- Follow the night-time supervision procedure providing adequate support for participants and staff during residential phases

NCS team training programme (office hours, 1 week)

- Participate and engage in the pre-programme training programme
- Take responsibility for own learning and reflection

Phase 1 (Be Epic) - Residential (5 days, 4 nights) aimed at team building:

- Supervise young people during all activities
- Be enthusiastic and participate in all activities
- Support activities and sessions which are not led by centre staff
- Provide pastoral care and support for young people



Phase 2 (Live Life) – Residential (5 days, 4 nights) focus on community awareness and engagement and planning Social Action Project:

- Follow structured timetable and support your group during activities and travel
- Be proactive and lead by example at all times
- Inspire and enthuse young people to develop independent living skills and wider social awareness
- Provide pastoral care and support for young people.

Phase 3 (Do Good)- Non-residential planning and implementing social action project (may not be on successive days, may include evenings and weekends)

- Facilitate young people to take the lead on the project delivery whilst monitoring its feasibility and advising adjustments where necessary.
- Support your group with the delivery of their project.
- Provide adult supervision and a BF presence at events and activities.
- Ensure Health and Safety procedures have been followed and incidents reported.

Celebration Event (Go Party) (will take place after all teams have completed their projects)

- Assist with the organisation and running of an event to celebrate the success of NCS Summer 2020.



Person Specification

Summary

We are looking for an energetic person, committed to engaging young people in exciting activities whilst supporting them to learn new personal and social skills. The right person for the role will be effective under pressure, have excellent decision making skills and above all, be reliable. Great communication skills and a passion for the outdoors are essential for this role.

Experience

- Demonstrable experience of building relationships with young people and of positive role modelling
- Experience of the NCS Programme
- Experience of engaging with a range of young people and knowledge of the issues they may be facing
- Relevant experience in working with young people in a variety of settings including residential
- Proven track record of achieving positive outcomes when working with young people and the ability to demonstrate this achievement
- Positive track record of delivering projects to a given timescale
- Independent working

Essential Skills and Qualifications

- Hold a full driving licence or be able to organise own transport to meet the demands of the role

Desirable Skills and Qualifications

- Hold a full driving licence with minibus entitlement (D1) and MIDAS accreditation
- Relevant Youth Work and/or Teaching Qualification, eg Level 2 in Youth Work, JNC Youth and Community Work, Sports Coaching, Outdoor Instructor qualifications.

More about the role:

NCS Summer 2020 is open to all 16 and 17-year-olds in England and is designed to enable participants to build skills for work and life. NCS encourages personal and social development by working on skills like leadership, teamwork and communication.

This role is to support two consecutive waves of 15 young people, through BF Adventure's NCS programme. The group will be drawn from a social mix of young people, from a variety of backgrounds. Some of the young people may have disabilities, mental health concerns, behavioural difficulties or complex needs. Each group of young people will have 2 members of staff allocated to them, a Team Leader and an Assistant Team Lead. You will be required to stay overnight during the residential elements of the programme.

The programme is split into 4 phases. Phase 1 (Be Epic) is residential at an activity centre with the opportunity for the teams to participate in adventurous activities designed to enable them to develop enhanced communication, team work and leadership skills. Phase 2 (Live Life) is also residential, but this time in a university type accommodation with a programme designed to develop independent living skills, and supporting their transition to adulthood. Phase 3 (Do Good) is about social action; for this element teams are based in their local area and design their social action project based upon their needs assessment of the locality. It's then time to put their social action project into practice! Phase 4 (Go Party) is all about graduation, celebration and moving forwards – taking the things they have learned from the programme and using them to make a positive difference to others.

Start of Wave 1: 29/6/20

End of Wave 1: 24/7/20

Start of Wave 2: 27/7/20

End of Wave 2: 21/8/20

Graduation: 23 and 24/9/20

Please note:

All team members must be able to commit to training week and must also be able to commit to a whole Wave, it is not possible to have time off mid wave without an exceptional reason as this can hinder relationship building with the group.
